





A high-profile location at the main library entrance, a refreshed lobby design and glass walls allow patrons to view the book sorting system in action.


Expanded sorting system provided by Library.

Adjacent to the makerspace, a high-tech digital lab for gaming, VR and creation of podcasts, videos and other media.





Adult Individual Study Room (4) Spaces for adults to collaborate with others or work individually.






Naming Opportunities: Youth Study Zone \$15,000 Children's Group Study Rooms (2)


